After Hours Supervision

Once students leave our school at 3.00pm, they are under the supervision of parents and carers. This includes community library days and when they meet to play in the skate park or playground after school. Our school often receives feedback from community members and parents about behaviour that is inappropriate or unsafe in the afternoons and involve students who attend our school. This includes use of inappropriate language in the community and climbing on the toilet block roof. This is not the school's responsibility to sort out unruly behaviour, arguing and social issues that occurs off school grounds.

Unfortunately this does sometimes lead to inschool social issues. If your child is experiencing problems after school at the library, in the park, playgrounds or skate ramps then they need your supervision.

We always enjoy the fresh faces our Kindergarten enrolment brings to our school. All smiles and no tears in the morning! They have already settled into their classroom and made new friends.






