The students loved panning for gold, visiting the underground mine, learning about earlier settlers and the struggles on the goldfields. They learnt more about the Eureka Stockade and how the Chinese were subject to racism and discrimination. The Aura light and sound show was amazing and students travelled under the night sky to re-live the rebellion and delve into the dreamtime. They really enjoyed the 3D film about how gold was formed and why it is on planet Earth. The staff did love winning the ten pin bowling at night in each lane and Jennifer also took home victory against a tough crowd. The boys were a little disappointed, due to their competitive nature! Thanks to Miss Schupfer and Miss Munro for attending the excursion with me and for working all those extra hours to give our students a great opportunity. 
Altina Wildlife Park


