NAPLAN

NAPLAN preparation will start this week to prepare the students for the three tests on the 14th-16th of May. It is imperative that your child attends for NAPLAN as they cannot complete the tests at a



later date. Also remember this is just one test and teachers collect assessments throughout the term to have a clear understanding of your child's needs.

Tests are returned to Sydney for marking. It is important to remember that these tests are just one form of assessment. In classes, students have the opportunity to show their understanding and knowledge in a variety of ways. Students do not have this opportunity in NAPLAN. As a teacher, I often wish students could respond orally instead of answering all questions in a written form. This is especially relevant for mathematics. In NAPLAN, questions are often written in a very complex way and can confuse students. All mathematics questions are within problems and not written in simple form. This is just one of the reasons why NAPLAN is very controversial. At our school, the students will be asked to complete their tests without pressure or feeling anxious. They will be simply asked to do their best.

ATTENDANCE

We are aiming for our students to average a weekly attendance rate of 92%, which is still below the state average. In Term 1, our average was very close to this figure which was a vast improvement on any term in 2018 and 2017. From an educational perspective, our school has poor attendance rates and it has been my aim to try and improve this in the best interest of your children. Please ensure your child is at school every day to maximise their learning opportunities. We understand that there can be isolated important family events and we are not near specialists doctors. If you do attend a doctor's appointment it is ideal to get a certificate as proof for the Department of Education. Attendance figures are collected and analysed by the department. If you know your child's teacher is going to be away please do not assume that they

will be doing nothing important. At our school, we continue our teaching program and child's your teacher plans and leaves work for the casual teacher.
