#### Swimming – Starts Friday

All students will be expected to participate in the Swimming Scheme starting this Friday. This will benefit all students. Swimming will be our sport on Friday. We will have an adjusted recess and lunch time. We would appreciate if all students could have a packed lunch on the day rather than lunch delivered to the office due to the shorter time slot and the staff needing to have their own limited lunchbreaks and organising students for swimming.

Recess: 9.50-10.00

Lunch: 11.00-11.30

The bus will leave at 12.00 and return at 2.45pm.

We ask all students to bring a swimming bag with:

- Towel
- Goggles if they wear them
- Thongs or slides to wear to the pool

Students will change at school and just take their swimming bag. Students will get changed though at the pool back into their uniform. Please ensure your child's uniform is labelled with their name. Students can wear thongs or slides to the swimming pool to save worrying about shoes and socks.

#### **Library Changes**

Due to swimming we will need to change the weekly library program. Please note when your child's class will have library:

- $\Rightarrow$  Class 1/2- Friday (no change)
- $\Rightarrow$  Year 3/4-Wednesday
- $\Rightarrow$  Year 5/6- Wednesday

#### **NAPLAN & Check-In Assessments**

This term our students will participate in two external assessments.

NAPLAN is an Australia-wide assessment for English and Mathematics. Students in Year 3 and 5 will participate. This is a paper-based test (we have opted for the paper version) that will be completed by students between May 4<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>. Each student will complete 4 tests. Results are shared with parents in September. It is important that your children attend on these days.

The Check-in Assessments is a NSW Public School assessment test for Reading and Numeracy. Students in Year 4 and 6 will participate. This is an online test that students will complete over the next three weeks. Each assessment is designed to be quick and easy to administer, consisting of approximately 40 multiple choice questions. Results are not shared with parents and used at school for planning and feedback.

Students with disabilities are not expected to complete these tests.

#### **Easter Day**

Thank you to the community for supporting our Easter Hat parade and coming to our assembly. It was lovely to see parents and families re-connect with the school and be part of the celebrations. Students had a fabulous day making their hats and participating in craft and games.





































#### Parent Survey

A survey went home the last week of school (Term 1) for parents to complete. We have not had many returned and this is an opportunity for you to share your opinion. At our school, we value your feedback. Your feedback is completely anonymous. We take our role very seriously and work hard to make sure your child receives the best education possible. While we are bound by curriculum, we want our students to enjoy school and be happy and enthusiastic about projects and extra activities we provide.

This is also an opportunity to hear positive things about our school. Principals are generally only ever contacted about negative issues or problems, so feel free to also tell us about things you think we do well. It is nice for staff to hear that their hard work is also appreciated.

#### **Attendance Issues**

Attendance remains a concern at our school and this has been highlighted by the Department of Education NSW. It is continually monitored and there are many students who have poor attendance and further action will need to be taken if this does not improve. Families can be given an 'improvement plan' from district office due to a student's attendance rate and average. This is currently why, I now need to collect medical certificates for students who are away sick for more than three days in a row. My attendance reminders in the WONGI are not a personal reminder to one person or family. Due to our poor attendance, I am legally obliged to place continual reminders in the newsletter until we have reached our attendance target.

#### Late

If you are dropping off students late, please ensure your child or children go to the office first so we can enter them on our attendance system. If you are able to, please also write a short note to explain why they are late, as we also need to enter this information on our system. Thank you for supporting our Department of Education NSW procedures.
