New report formatting does not include a general comment now. We will continue to print reports at this stage, but the department are moving towards giving parents only a digital copy in the near future.

Our new reports contain more information about the topics and subject content than in previous years.

All comments will address a future direction and area of improvement for students achieving above the expected level.




