We have a number of things coming up on the calendar:


- Book Week Parade & Morning Tea this Friday 10.30 (a note went home about this)

- Swimming teacher training for some staff


News from Miss Hogan








Technology with Mrs Wheeler


K/1Students can login to their portals, comment in Google Classroom and are creating a slideshow on Seasons.



















Year 4/5/6
